Dear Ms. Baird:

This is in response to your January 25, 2017, correspondence concerning Brandywine Creek Road in Chester County. PennDOT's District Geotechnical Unit reviewed the conditions on Brandywine Creek Road on January 31, 2017, and has determined that the road is stable for controlled, one-way traffic in the area of the slope failures.

The department has completed a design to restrict Brandywine Creek Road to one-way traffic in the eastbound direction from Strasburg Road to Powell Road. Signs have been ordered and the new traffic pattern will be implemented upon their delivery. In addition, the department will install delineating devices along the outer edge of the roadway to keep traffic away from the areas of concern.

The department plans to restore this section of Brandywine Creek Road to two-way traffic through the programming of a project to rebuild the roadway and reestablish its structural integrity. We will program the project and move it to construction once we secure the necessary funds and complete final engineering design.
