***Adopting the Updated Newlin Township
Emergency Operations Plan***

WHEREAS, Section 7503 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S. Section 7101 et seq. mandates that municipalities prepare, maintain, and keep current an Emergency Operations Plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster within their boundaries; and


WHEREAS, in response to this mandate, Newlin Township has prepared the **Newlin Township Emergency Operations Plan** to provide prompt and effective emergency response procedures to be followed in the event of a major emergency or disaster; and


WHEREAS, Newlin Township has prepared the **Newlin Township Emergency Operations Plan** in order to reduce the potential effects of a major emergency or disaster and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Township;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the **Newlin Township Emergency Operations Plan** is hereby approved, adopted, and placed into immediate effect. This Plan will be reviewed on an annual basis to make certain that it is effective and conforms to the requirements of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code and is in agreement with the **Chester County Emergency Operations Plan**.


